## Key stage 4 Curriculum

All pupils will continue to study a 'Core Curriculum' and then have the opportunity to select <u>UP TO</u> FOUR ADDITIONAL OPTION SUBJECTS

Core Curriculum at KS4

- ♦ English (two GCSEs in Language and Literature)
- Mathematics GCSE
- Science Trilogy (equivalent of two GCSEs with option to select Triple Science for many pupils)
- Philosophy, Religion and Ethics (short course—examined in year 10)
- Citizenship (year 9 only)
- Computing (year 9 only)
- Recreational PE

Most pupils will also study a Humanities subject and a Language as part of their core curriculum. The remainder of their timetable will comprise of other subjects that they are able to choose themselves, allowing them to focus on particular strengths or areas of interest.

Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE), sex and relationships education and careers are an important part of our Key Stage 4 curriculum will be delivered in tutor time and at other points throughout the year and through the year 9 Citizenship lessons.
