KS5 Results



We are really excited to announce that Y13 students have achieved **SNA's best ever results at A2 level.**

Headlines at A2 are:

- A*-A grades = 23%
- A*-B grades = 50%
- Average points score per candidate = 765.23
- Average points score per entry = 216.03

Students received excellent collections of results such as A*AA and we are very pleased that students secured the pathways of their choice. A student gained a full scholarship for Northwestern University USA and students gained top Russell Group Universities places at Durham, Leeds and Birmingham. These were for highly competitive places on courses such as English Literature and the Sciences. Students also secured unconditional offers due to excellent personal statements and personalised, detailed references.

We are extremely proud of all of our Sixth Form students for their hard work and dedication. Their results are well deserved and we wish them all the luck in their future, they will be sorely missed!

KS4 Results

We are pleased to announce that results at the Academy continue to improve.

- Students achieving A*- C in English and Mathematics 60% **(5% increase)**
- Students achieving A*- C in English 68% **(7% increase)**
- Students achieving A*- C in Maths 68% **(1% decrease)**
- Students achieving 5A*- C including English and Mathematics 53% **(4% increase)**
- Students achieving the English Baccalaureate 22% **(9% increase)**

Achieving higher grades (A*- A)

- **Students achieving 1A* - A = 47%** (Up 8% compared to 2014 results)
- **Students achieving 3A* - A = 13%** (Equal to 2014 results)
- **Students achieving 5A* - A = 5%** (Equal to 2014 results)
- **Students achieving 8A* - A = 2%** (Down 1% compared to 2014 results)
